BYLAW NO. 7-84

A BYLAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN
MUNICIPALLY AS PELLY MUSEUM PELLY.
AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL, HISTORICAL OR NATURAL VALUE

WHEREAS Part 111 of The Heritage Property Act, 1980, authorizes the council of a municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural, historical or natural value or interest;

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Pelly has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as Pelly Museum at Pelly, Saskatchewan, a Notice of Intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in at least two issues of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality with the first publication at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the date of consideration of the bylaw and with the last publication at least seven (7) days prior to the date of that consideration;

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the clerk of the municipality;

WHEREAS the Saskatchewan Heritage Property Review Board has held a hearing to determine whether the property in question should be designated and reported its findings of fact and recommendations to the Council,

WHEREAS the Council has considered the report of the Saskatchewan Heritage Property Review Board;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Pelly enacts as follows:


1. There is designated as being of architectural, historical or natural value the real property known as Pelly Museum at Pelly, Saskatchewan, and legally described as: West ½ Block Six (6) Plan No. AF-3959.

The significance of the site is as follows:
Historical and Architectural value and Tourist attraction.

2. The municipal clerk is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Titles Office.

3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this bylaw to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Minister of Culture and Youth, and to cause notice of the passing of this bylaw,

Introduced and read a first time this 4 th day of Oct. A.D. 1984. Read a second time this 4 th day of Oct. A.D. 1984. Read a third time and passed by unanimous consent of the Council Present this 4 th day of October A.D. 1984.
