## GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

## VILLAGE OF PELLY

## BYLAW NO. 2-85

A bylaw to provide for penalties for contravention of bylaws.

The Council of the Village of Pelly, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
- Section 3 applies only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other fine is provided.
- 3. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of The Urban Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) and costs for every offence.
- 4. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of The Urban Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) and costs for every offence.
- 5. Bylaw No. 2-59 passed July 7 th 1959 is hereby repealed.
