VILLAGE OF PELLY BYLAW NO. 4 - 89

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE A UNIFORM SYSTEM FOR THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND OTHER BUILDINGS IN THE VILLAGE OF PELLY.

The Council of the Village of Pelly, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. That a uniform system of numbering houses and other buildings as shown on the attached map and which shall become part of this Bylaw shall be used in the Village of Pelly.
- 2. That all existing numbers of houses and other buildings not now conforming with the provisions of this Bylaw shall be changed to conform to the system herein adopted.
- A seperate number shall be assigned for each FIFTY feet of frontage.
- 4. Each house and/or building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated. In case a house or building is occupied by more than one family dwelling unit or business, each seperate front entrance of said house or building shall bear a seperate number.
- 5. Numerals indicating the official number of each house or building or each front entrance to such building shall be posted in a manner as to be visible from the street on which the property is located.
- 6. The Clerk of the Village of Pelly shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system and shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this Bylaw.
- 7. This Bylaw shall come into force the Fifteenth day of June, 1989.
