# VILLAGE OF PELLY BYLAW NO. 1-90

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH THE PELLY AND DISTRICT RECREATION BOARD.

The Council of the **VILLAGE** of **PELLY**, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

### **DEFINITION:**

- In this bylaw, including this section;
  - (a) "board" means the recreation board appointed pursuant to this bylaw.
  - (b) "council" means the council of the VILLAGE of PELLY.
  - (c) "Municipality" means the R.M. of ST. PHILIPS and LIVINGSTON.
  - (d) "Recreation Director" means the recreation director appointed by the Council.
  - (e) "program" means those activities normally carried on in culture, recreation and sport.

#### FUNCTION:

- 2. The function of the Board shall be:
  - (a) to advise and assist in pbtaining grants to operate the following facilities:
    - i Curling Rink
    - ii Skating Rink
    - iii Museum
    - iv Recreation Programs
  - (b) to advise Council on projects to improve or extend any of the recreation activities.

# COMPOSITION OF BOARD:

- 3. The Board shall consist of SEVEN members, to be appointed by resolution of Council as follows:
  - (a) 1 member of Council
  - (b) 1 representative from the Curling Club.
  - (c) 1 representative from the Skating Rink.
  - (d) 1 representative from the R.M. of St. Philips.
  - (e) 1 representative from the R.M. of Livingston
  - (f) 1 representative from the Village of Pelly
  - (g) 1 representative from the Museum
- 4. At the first appointment of the board members, the terms of office shall be as follows:
  - (a) 2 members for one year term.
  - (b) 2 members for two year terms.
  - (c) 3 members for three year terms.
- 5. (a) Subject to Section 4 each term of office shall be three years.
- 6. The board ( Council ) shall appoint one member as

- 11. The Council shall, by resolution, at the first meeting following receipt of the notice of vacancy, fill the vacancy.
- 12. Four (4) members shall constitute a quorum.

### MEETINGS:

- 13. The board shall meet at least Once a month, at a time and place, as set by resolution of the board at the first meeting of the board each year.
- 14. The secretary-treasurer of the board shall, at the request of the chairperson or one third of the members call a special meeting at a date specified in the request.
- 15. All meetings of the board shall be open to the public.
- 16. All members of the board present shall vote on each question.
- 17. The Chairperson shall preside at all meetings.
- 18. If the chairperson should be unable to attend the meeting, the vice chairperson shall preside.
- 19. All actions of the board shall be entered in a minute book , to be kept for that purpose by the secretary-treasurer and signed by the presiding officer and secretary-treasurer.
- 20. The chairperson shall, monthly, report in person to the Council and shall provide a written report, on the activities of the board, at the December Council meeting.
- 21. An annual meeting of the residents of the municipality and other interested persons, shall be held in November of each year.
- 23. At the annual meeting, the secretary-treasurer of the board shall present, for approval, the audited financial statement of the previous year, as well as an interim financial report of the current years operation.

# POWERS AND DUTIES:

- 24. The board shall establish annual goals and objectives.
- 25. The financial year of the board shall be the caleadar year.
- 26. The board shall submit a copy of its assessment of the recreation needs and its early goals and objectives to council before February 1 of each year.
- 27. The board shall before March 1 of each year, prepare a budget, being an estimate of its proposed revenues and expenditures for the current calendar year operations.
- 28. The board shall within its budgetary allotment manage and initiate various recreational programs.
- 29. The board may advise council in all matters placed before its dealing with culture, recreation and sport.
- 30. All volunteers working for the board shall be considered agents of the municipality.

- 34. The board shall encourage and co-operate with organizations in the promotion of programs.
- 35. Bylaw 3-79 is herby repealed.
- 36. This bylaw shall come into effect January 12, 1990
