

BYLAW NO. 4-96

A bylaw to enter into agreement with the Pelly and District Sports Association for the purpose of providing exemption from taxation.

The Council in the Village of Pelly, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The Village of Pelly is hereby authorized to enter into agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw and identified as "Exhibit A of Bylaw 4-94", with the Pelly and District Sports Association.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to sign and execute the attached agreement identified as "Exhibit A of Bylaw No. 4-96".
3. That the Village of Pelly provide exemption of taxation to the following property operated by the Pelly and District Sports Association.

Block B, Plan 78Y03677 (Skating Rink)

shall be exempt from taxation, for the improvement and land assessment for a one year period.


The Pelly and District Sports Association

That in consideration of the mutual agreements and understandings herein, the parties hereto covenant and agree with each other, as follows:

1. That the Pelly and District Sports Association maintains the ice and kitchen areas of the Pelly Skating Rink, collects fees from users of the building, pays for water charges assessed to the building and generally operates the Pelly Skating Rink for the year 1996.
2. That in exchange for the above services the land and improvements on Block B, Plan 78Y03677, in the village of Pelly, in the Province of Saskatchewan be exempted from taxation for the year 1996.
3. That this property be subjected to review January 1, 1997 in regards to taxation.
