

BYLAW NO. 1-2000

A BYLAW RESPECTING SMOKING

Whereas it has been determined that second-hand tobacco smoke and side-stream smoke from idling cigarettes, cigars and pipes is a health hazard and causes discomfort for some residents and participants in the Village of Pelly;

And whereas it is desirable for the health, safety and welfare of the residents and participants in the Village of Pelly, to regulate smoking in the municipal buildings in the Village of Pelly as is more particularly set out in this bylaw;

Now therefore, the council of the Village of Pelly enacts as follows:

1. No person shall smoke in any portion of the following municipal buildings;
 - The Pelly Community Hall
 - The Pelly Mini Mall
 - The Pelly Skating Rink
 - The Pelly Curling Rink
 - The Pelly Village Office
 - The Pelly Library
 - The Pelly Shop
 - The Pelly Fire Hall, including the Lion's Den
 - The Pelly Water Treatment Plant
 - The Pelly Sewer Lift Station
 - The Pelly Pump House
 - The Pelly Museum
 - The Pelly Sports Ground Concession Stands
2. The Pelly Village Council shall display prominently smoking prohibited signs.
3. Where a sign is required to be displayed pursuant to the bylaw, the sign is to;
 - a) contain the words "No Smoking" or the international symbol for no smoking;
 - b) contain at the bottom the words, "No Smoking Bylaw No. 1-2000, and;
 - c) be of a size and displayed in such manner that a person may determine without difficulty whether the area is a no smoking or smoking permitted area.
4. A person who contravenes this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than \$25.00 for the first offence and not more than \$50.00 for each subsequent offence.
