

DOG BREED BYLAW

VILLAGE OF PELLY

BYLAW NO. 04-2019

A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE OWNERSHIP OF CERTAIN BREEDS OF DOGS

The Council of the Village of Pelly in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. This bylaw may be referenced as "The Dog Breed Bylaw".
2. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - "controlled breed" shall mean purebred, crossbred or any variation of **Rottweiler or Doberman or Pitbull**
 - "Municipality" shall mean the Village of Pelly
3. Any person keeping, possessing or harboring a controlled breed within the limits of the Municipality shall ensure that the dog(s) are secured on his/her property.
4. If the controlled breed dog is removed from the enclosure, the dog shall be on a leash and in control by the owner at all times.
5. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the following penalties;
 - \$100.00 for the first offense
 - \$200.00 for the second offense
 - Removal of the dog from the boundaries of the Municipality for the third offense
6. Should any charges go to court, the dog owner must pay all court fees incurred by both the owner and Village of Pelly.

PREPAYMENT OPTION:

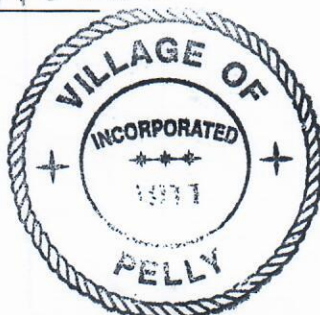
7. WHERE payment of the penalty issued under this bylaw is received within 30 days of date of serving of such penalty, by the Village of Pelly, such payment, the penalty set out in this bylaw hereof, may be reduced by FIFTY PERCENT (50%) and such reduced payment shall be accepted in lieu of prosecution.
8. Bylaw #4-2015 is hereby repealed.







