


A BYLAW TO REQUIRE CRIMINAL RECORD CHECKS WITH NOMINATION FORMS

The Council of the Village of Pelly in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:¹

1. Every candidate for municipal office shall obtain a criminal record check at their own expense.
2. The criminal record check² shall be included with and form part of the nomination form submitted by the candidate for municipal office.






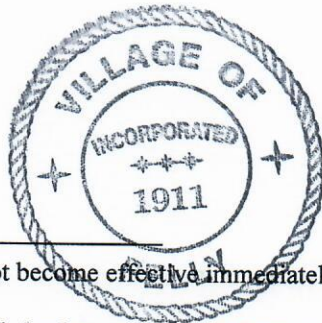

¹ This bylaw does not become effective immediately. It must be passed at least 90 days prior to a general election.

² The criminal record check must be in the form prescribed by the minister (Form A.2 in cities, Form B.1 in other municipalities) and it will include the form issued by the RCMP or local police department.
