BYLAW NO. 2019-06

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF PELLY TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 2016-01, WHICH IS A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A CODE OF ETHICS FOR COUNCIL MEMBERS

Short Title

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Amendment to the Code of Ethics Bylaw"

Legal Requirement

- 2. This bylaw has been created to comply with section 93.1 of The Municipalities Act and as outlined in section 3.1, Schedule 1, of Municipalities Regulations.

The Council of the Village of Pelly in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 3. That Clause 3 Complaint Procedure subsection (d) be amended as follows: delete "5 (a) to (f)" and replace it with "5 (a) to (g)."

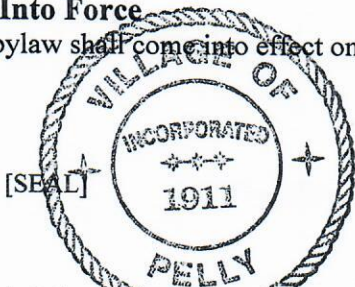
- 4. That Clause 5 Remedial Action if Contravention Occurs be amended to read as follows:

Remedial Action if Contravention Occurs

- 5. (1) Should a Member of a Council breach any of the principles outlined in this code, the possible courses of action that are available to Council include but are not limited to:
a. An apology, either written and/or verbal, by the Member of Council to the impacted individual(s), Council, and/or the general public.
b. Educational training on ethical and respectful conduct, role of Council members or other topic relating to municipal governance.
c. Repayment of moneys/gifts received.
d. Removal of the Member from Council Committees and/or bodies.
e. Dismissal of the Member from a position of Chairperson of a Committee.
f. Reprimand.
g. Subject to other provisions of this section, Suspension in accordance with clause 93.1 (6) (b) of The Municipalities Act.
(2) Suspension means the suspension of the council member's powers and duties of a council member for a specified period, including attendance at council meetings.
(3) The period of suspension shall be specified but cannot exceed 45 days.
(4) A council member who has been suspended is not entitled to any remuneration as a council member for the period of suspension.
(5) The council member's absence from a council meeting due to a suspension pursuant to this section is not an absence for the purposes of clause 147 (1) (c) of The Municipalities Act.

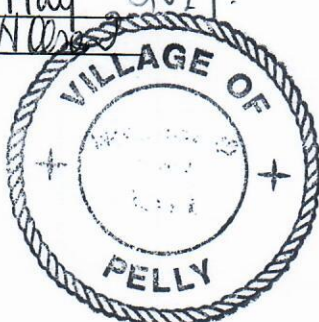
Coming Into Force
